

II. General Meeting of the Society

The meeting was called to order by President-General Pyne at 3:00 P.M., October 11, 1975 at the First Parish Church, Concord, Massachusetts.

Reverend DeForest gave the prayer of the Society.

First Vice President-General Haneman introduced the new members.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read by Secretary-General Wood and were approved as read. In the absence of Treasurer-General Hopkinson, there was no Treasurer's report.

Registrar-General Kalbfleisch reported 28 new Senior members and 14 new Junior members, 2 reinstatements and 1 resignation giving a total membership of 656 Seniors and 276 Juniors.

Reporting for the Bi-Centennial Committee, Mr. Goodsell announced that through the generosity of The Sons of Cincinnati, Anderson House will be available for the dinner at the March meeting. He also reported that the Bas Relief is or soon will be on its way to the capital and that the cost of installation will be \$200.00.

President-General Pyne announced that the Plaque will be placed in the East Portico of the Capitol on Saturday, March 20, 1976 in a 30 minute ceremony.

Governor for Massachusetts, Barbara Walker welcomed the membership to Massachusetts and presented greetings from Governor of the Commonwealth, Michael Dukakis, Charles Francis Adams, Thomas Boyleston Adams and sent our greetings to National Trust President James Biddle.

Governor for Virginia, Rieman McNamara reported a current State membership of 90 and announced a meeting at Stratford Hall Plantation in October.

Governor for Pennsylvania, William Ward, reported that efforts are continuing in the organization of July 4, 1976 ceremonies at Independence Hall as well as the proposed artifacts exhibit.

The membership of the Society approved amendments to the Constitution lowering the minimum age of Senior members to 18 years and leaving the sum for Life Membership at the discretion of the Board of Governors.



He expressed the hope that more of the membership would become involved in the various committees and that the plan to increase the information in the Bulletin would enable members to be more knowledgeable in the Society's affairs. He told of the special Board meeting which was dedicated to a review of the Society's Constitution and By-Laws and suggested that after the Bi-Centennial Plaque, the Society would continue to pursue meaningful goals.

Registrar-General Kalbfleisch announced a gift to the Society by Mrs. William Francis Brown of two books: Emblem of Destiny by Helen C. Sadler and Virginia Out Front by Pocohantas Wight Edmunds.

Mr. Goodsell called the Roll of Signers.
